10 Oz. Silver Bar Featuring the Morgan Silver Dollar Design

There is nothing quite as exciting for investors as opening a package filled with bullion bars such as the 10 oz. Morgan Design Silver Bar. The wonderful thing about the Morgan design bar is that it will bring joy to the heart of the silver collector inside the serious silver investor.

The design of this 10 oz. silver bar features the obverse image of the Morgan dollar coin. The coin was named after a U.S. Mint Assistant Engraver named George T. Morgan. Morgan designed the coin's obverse to represent an American Lady Liberty rather than a Greek-style Liberty such as had been featured on American coins in the past. Above the portrait on the coin are the words "E Pluribus Unum."

Morgan chose Anna Willess Williams, a woman he considered the most beautiful woman in the world, as his model. The coin gained a certain notoriety at the time, because it was considered scandalous that Williams, a married woman, had five sittings with Morgan as he was creating the design. This caused the coin to become even more popular than it already was.

Silver legislation at the time prevented the coin from being struck immediately after its design. However, the Director of the Mint told Morgan to prepare the dies for the new silver bill that was expected to pass soon. The coin was minted from 1878 to 1904. Then, the silver law changed. The Mint stopped production of the Morgan dollar until 1921, when it was again legal for one year.

Do precious metals bars ever have numismatic value? In addition to their primary use as silver bullion investments, 10 oz. Silver Bars with the Morgan design do offer investors the pleasure of collecting unusual bars with the same design features as the Morgan Silver coin obverse.

In the early 1960s, U.S. citizens were allowed to exchange silver certificates for Morgan silver dollars from the Philadelphia Mint. When the U.S. Treasury discovered 2.8 million Carson City Morgan dollars in their vaults, they received a generous marketing allowance to sell these last coins.

Below the Morgan dollar image, the 10 oz. Silver Bar with this Morgan design also features the weight of "Ten Troy Ounces," and "Fine Silver 999+," along with a nod to its country of origin in the words "Made in the U.S.A." A waffle print design covers the reverse of the bar.

In general, you can buy silver bars for very little over their spot price. Silver bars retain their value in most market conditions and increase slowly over time. The Morgan dollar imprint does not usually affect the value of the silver bar, unless you find a buyer who is particularly fond of that coin. For these reasons, it is best to consider silver bars – even the 10 oz. Silver Bar Morgan design – as long term bullion investments.
